### 4. Principals Report:

- Excellent start to the school year. All EA's, Teachers and our YSW have listed different strategies they will implement to closely connect with students. This is part of our social emotional learning focus for this year
- Our gr 7-9 completed a COMPASS survey that reported results in many comprehensive health topics for teenagers. Some topics of concern include healthy eating/positive body image, vaping/smoking/ alcohol and bullying. The

school is responding by hosting a MADD Canada presentation, a vaping presentation by Lung NS/PEI and PEI Nurses. We have also booked La Table Des Chefs from Montreal to do a healthy eating and positive body image cooking class with our grade 7-9 students. The grade 9 class filled out a federal grant application to pay for the sessions. \* Home and School would like the results from the compass survey shared at the next meeting. It would be interesting to see what topics are of importance to our students and if home and school could support some initiatives to address these \*

- As part of our support of truth and reconciliation we have added the 7 sacred teaching our bulldog of the month assembly. The 7 teachings have lessons around Truth, Respect, Love, Humility, courage, Wisdom and Honesty. The grade 7-9 Explorations class taught these topics to our k-6's. It was well received
- We are inviting families to come to our bulldog assemblies (started in october) \
- "Kindness Shout-outs" Is a new initiative started by our staff leadership committee. Any staff/guest at the school can submit a shout-out if they notice an act of kindness. We have recognized 20+ students to date.
- Fall sports were successful. We had Cross country, golf, and volleyball. Wrestling team is operating through the school week. There were 19 students participating in cross country and 4 who went to provincials. Kayley Carter (20th), Simon Beck (48th), Syrianna Desousa (63rd) and Elsa Laybolt (93rd). Girls volleyball team finished with a record of 3-3 and didn't advance to the provincials. The Boys Volleyball team finished 2-3 records and advanced to the provincials. There were two boys golf teams, no one advanced to the provincials. We had 4 girl golfers who all advanced to the provincials (Kayley Carter, Abbie Bell, Ally Myers and Milla Beck. Abbie was our top finisher with 5th place. The girls' scramble team won silver (Milla, Abbey, Ally).
- Home and School's first Halloween spooktacular was a success. There was lots
  of positive feedback. Thank you for all your hard work. Grade 9's raised 575\$,
  Thank you Tonia and Rose for the donation of popcorn maker, cinnamon rolls
  and donations.
- Grade ¼ attended an Art Discovery Day and the Confederation Centre. Would home and school be willing to make a motion to cover the cost of bussing (Approx \$250) \*see New Business
- The Earth rangers presentation was well received, students really enjoyed it
- Grade 9's participated in "take your kid to work day"
- Remembrance day assembly will be held Friday November 10th. (Time TBA, likely 10:30
- Bingo night is scheduled to go Friday November 10th from 6:30-8:30.
- We have two spirit days coming up November 7th is jersey day, November 14th is PJ day
